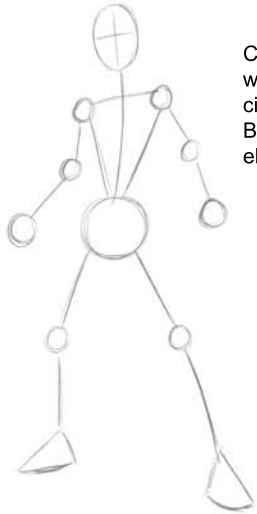


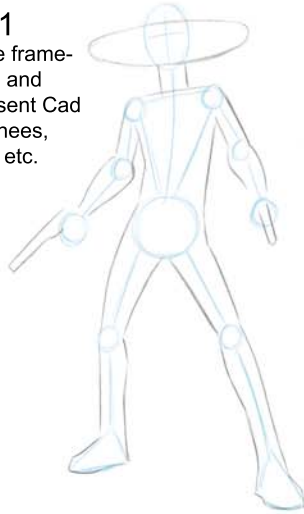
# STAR THE CLONE WARS

The *Star Wars*™ galaxy is filled with the untold stories of the heroic Jedi Knights, their ruthless enemies and a variety of intergalactic creatures. Use the Force and the visuals below to write out your own Clone Wars worthy adventure and may the Force be with you™!



## Step 1

Create a simple framework. Use lines and circles to represent Cad Bane's head, knees, elbows, hands, etc.



## Step 2

Once your stick figure framework is done, start drawing in Bane's body shape lightly with your pencil. Use your lines from Step 1 to guide you. Cad Bane has a wide brim hat, so be sure to draw an oval from his chin to his forehead that extends far beyond his shoulders to either side.



## Step 3

Now that your basic shapes and pose are in place, it's time to lightly pencil in some of the more detailed areas that represent his forearms, side holsters, face, and so on. Keep your lines loose and light, and don't be afraid to erase and redraw.



## Step 4

Create your final pencil drawing. Go over the lines and shapes you've already drawn, but this time make it a bit darker. The amount of detail that goes into your final pencil drawing is completely up to you. Keep working with it until you're happy with how it looks.



## Step 5

If you want, you can go over your drawing with pen to make it more permanent. Simply draw over your pencil lines with a pen and when you're happy with it, go over the drawing with an eraser to get rid of the pencil lines. Remember, it doesn't have to be perfect the first time. Practicing is the key to getting better!



## Step 6

If you want, you can color your drawing as well. Use crayons, colored pencils, markers or whatever you want to complete Cad Bane.
